Certificate in Level 1- "Choices in the Community"

The programme "Choices in the Community" Learning is designed to run on a part-time basis over a one year period, depending on the learners' needs and progress.

This programme leads to a Level 1 Certificate in General Learning through the completion of four programme modules which includes five component specifications.

It aims to build basic skills, knowledge and competence across a range of areas including making personal choices, communicating effectively, socialising safely, and using everyday technology at home, work and in the community.

Certificate in Level 1- "My Career Plan"

This programme is available to deliver and is designed to lead to a certificate in General Learning Level 1. The programme is part time and run over 1 year. It consists of five modules which support the learner in choosing and developing a career plan. The components covered will include;

The learner builds knowledge in I.T. through exploring varied work options using a career based software package. The learner is encouraged to explore their own strengths and areas for development in relation to choosing a career.
